

# Free Spring Break Trolley Service Returns

Park in Downtown Clearwater and Ride to Clearwater Beach

Pinellas Suncoast Transit Authority (PSTA) and the city of Clearwater have

partnered once again to provide free park and ride during Spring Break.

From March 1 through April 30, anyone can park for free in the former city hall parking lot (112 S. Osceola Ave) seven days a week. A trolley or bus will pick up every 30 minutes from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Thursday and every 15 minutes from 10 a.m. to midnight on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Return service to the Park & Ride lot boards at the Clearwater Beach Marina (25 Causeway Blvd.). Additional parking areas are available Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.


